Local Action Phase

3 months action phase where participants with support of their local organizations will put in action the gained knowledge and experience to organise their workshops and educational activities.

International Dissemination Phase

Participants and partner organisations will share the project outcomes (videos, photos and guide book) from the project on marketing channels to reach relevant audience.

PROGRAM

We have an intense program consised of workshops, games, trainings, creative labs and sessions from 9 am to 20 pm (breaks included). We also have optional evening sessions hosted by trainers or participants.

- Non-formal Education with self-engagement and active participation
- Facilitative approach of group communication and processes
- Kolb cycle of experiential learning with reflection
- Challenge and game-based learning
- Body expression and embodiment
- Non-violent communication





VENUE

The training will take place in the Scouts Environmental education centre <u>Kaprálův mlýn</u> surrounded by beautiful nature. It is close to Brno and easily reachable from Prague, Vienna or Bratislava. Accommodation will be in rooms of 4-6 people with shared bathrooms.



FOOD

We will have meals 3 times a day and coffee breaks for snack and drinks. The food will be mostly plant-based diet. Special diet can be arranged upon agreement.



FINANCIAL ARRANGMENTS

This training course is co-financed thanks to Erasmus+ programme. Accommodation, food, materials, programme and the travel cost up to the reimbursement limit are fully covered.

PARTICIPANT'S CONTRIBUTION IS 50€

This is considered as a symbolic contribution for participant's own experience and learning. I will be used to cover some part of the project costs. Contribution will be paid in cash on arrival day. If someone cannot afford to pay the contribution we can discuss individual agreements to reduce the fee or make it without.



TRAVEL REIMBURSMENT

Travel costs will be reimbursed up to limit stated in the table. If the costs are higher, the difference is covered by the participant. We encourage to use Green travel option with higher reimbursement limits and extended travel duration to a maximum 6 days.

We will reimburse the travel costs only in case of participation in the whole project and delivery of original travel tickets, boarding passes and invoices. The reimbursement will be sent 2 - 3 months after the training course, once participants sent the originals of the tickets, fill the evaluation form and take part in dissemination and follow-up activities.
