PROMOTER

Associação Check-IN – Cooperação e Desenvolvimento (Check-IN Association – Cooperation and Development) is a non-profit organization, founded in 2010, based in Beja and also operating from Lisbon, in Portugal. It works in close cooperation with public and private entities, actively participating in quality of life improvement activities.

Our organization mainly focuses on youth and adult mobility, non-formal education, cooperation and development of organizations and individuals and the overall sharing of knowledge, through the support of European cooperation initiatives.

We work on a regular basis with other organizations, as well as municipalities, universities and higher education institutions in Europe and all around the world (we built partnerships and developed projects in Brazil, Tanzania, Nepal, Argentina, Mexico and Peru).

CERCIBEJA

Cercibeja, not aiming to obtain profits, aims at social solidarity, education and the development of support activities in different areas of intervention for people with disabilities or with problems of socio-professional insertion, aiming at the defense of their individual rights and citizenship, namely in the context of promoting the right to equal opportunities.2. In the context of the spirit enshrined in the previous point, the following main purposes of the cooperative are: a) To develop information and awareness-raising activities with the public for the problems associated with the defense of the rights of the disabled and family; b) Promote the development of the capacities of children, young people and adults with disabilities or with serious problems in terms of social inclusion and the acquisition of school and professional knowledge necessary for their adequate integration in society, the full exercise of citizenship rights and the realization, as harmonious and complete as possible, of their personalities; c) Promote the development of activities to support people with serious problems in terms of autonomy, aiming to promote.

TASKS

The volunteers will support the team on Self Representation. Together develop different activities, according to the profile of the volunteers, with the group of self-representatives of Cercibeja, namely: promotion of information, awareness actions for the elements; organization and promotion of information, awareness, other actions with members of the group of self-representatives aimed at the community. The Volunteers support the team in the organization and realization of various activities; recreational, sports, cultural and other events, promoted by Cercibeja, which intend to involve and raise awareness in the community in general for the integration of people with disabilities (eg. Colorful Night, Colorful Summer, sporting events, exhibitions, seminars, among others).

ASSOCIAÇÃO ESTAR

Estar Association (ESTAR) aims to promote initiatives aimed at immediate intervention in situations of risk within the scope of social protection, such as ensuring social referral and monitoring in the processes of integration, insertion and autonomy. Its field of action is with vulnerable groups, meeting their immediate needs following situations of risk, developing a first-line service, operating 24 hours a day, and aimed at supporting individuals and families in the prevention and/or repair of problems that generate or have been generated by situations of social exclusion and, in certain cases, acting in situations of emergency and risk. The differentiating factor is the ability to respond and intervene immediately, aiming at people's well-being, in a perspective of firefighter intervention. In other words, to act in crisis situations, in the shortest, most immediate and effective time possible to solve the problems, aiming to recover the comfort and immediate well-being of the person and/or the family.

It has a focus on child support, a Children's Center that welcomes children from 4 months to 6 years. It integrates the gardening company, which was once founded as an insertion company, however, it is currently a service available to the community, within its area of operation. Always keeping in mind a continuous work of service to others, we do not neglect the social innovation and renewal associated with the project that we embrace with the same spirit and solidity, dedicating ourselves to those who need it most, but offering quality and professionalism.

TASKS

The volunteer would work mainly in the general daily process of SCM Beja: Founding of international partnerships is one of the main topics of the work. For this project, a high interest in organization/marketing and a will to do use and develop English skills are important.

The project is innovative promise for enlargement of sociability prospects and opportunities for social inclusion in Beja, blaming a youth group project for exchanges and exchanges of national and international nature experiences with audiences from different socio-economic contexts, cultural and different backgrounds, fostering youth mobility.

Activities and events of the Children's Center, which promotes the cultural and artistic opportunities to stimulate and develop the creative potential of every child, in strengthening their self-esteem and their social recognition, particularly in the field of Dance, Plastic Arts, Painting and Ceramics. ASSOCIACAO CHECK-IN – PORTUGAL

TASKS

The volunteering activity proposed is designed to empower the community and, the volunteers through solidarity and cooperation by enhancing the beneficiaries' skills and competences both the people from the community (children, youngsters and stakeholders) and also volunteers. The main volunteering activity will be to promote and give information about the ESC, Erasmus+, European Union, international opportunities and the volunteers' cultures. The volunteers will go to schools and universities in Beja to promote the values of the European Union, their experience and the importance of youth participation and active citizenship as well as their cultures, perspectives and differences from their countries; promoting then the multicultural dialogue and promote tolerance for difference and diversity. By going to different schools and universities, the volunteers will tackle various groups of young people, from young children to adults, because it is important to address youth in various stages of age. Many of the children and youngsters the volunteers will have an impact on, are youngsters with fewer opportunities since Beja is a city with many rural areas. The volunteers will also be responsible of organising an exposition about their culture and country. Moreover the volunteers will organize workshops, fairs, language exchange groups, boardgame sessions (using the 2 Board Games Check-IN has developed under KA2 projects, one game about financial literacy and the other about resources management), intercultural evenings and human library sessions where each volunteer will be a book and will be sharing his/her ESC experience.







BUDGET

You will receive 150€ Food Money + 155€ Pocket Money. The monthly allowance of the participant will be received between the 1st and the 4th of each month. The volunteer needs to give all financial documents to the Receiving Organization, between until 25 of the months before. This amount can change it because depending on your sending organization.

TRAVEL

The sending organization to support the travel to Lisbon Airport and after Check-IN support the volunteer to Beja. Check-In will transfer the money of travel to each participants after arrive in Portugal.

COMMODATION

The volunteer will be hosted in Residents of Students. We provided to the volunteer an apartmenttotally equipped (washing machine, dishware, sheets, blankets, towels, bed clothes for the entireperiod of the project), toilet, laundry facilities and living room. The volunteer will share apartment with people for the same gender and have a double room in this apartment with other volunteer.. You don't need to bring anything to the rooms and kitchen.









PORTUGAL - HISTORY

A piece of land planted in the edge of the ocean. Previous called as Lusitânia (from latin Lux Citânia - meaning the Land of Light), Portugal traces its national origin to 24 June 1128, with theBattle of São Mamede. Afonso proclaimed himself first Prince of Portugal and in 1139 the first King of Portugal. By 1143, with the assistance of a representative of the Holy See at the conference of Zamora, Portugal was formally recognized as independent, with the prince recognized as Dux Portucalensis. In 1179 Afonso Henriques was declared, by the Pope, as king.

CULTURE

The most famous part of the portuguese culture is Fado (it means Fate), a type of music that is conected to the word without translation, Saudade (a mix between melancholy, sadness, missingsomething or somebody, love, emotion and feelings). It's considered Intangible Cultural Heritage, by Unesco. The most famous fado singer was Amália Rodrigues. Nowadays new names and ways of singing fado are appearing, like Mariza, Ana Moura, Carminho, amoung others.

BEJA

This municipal area of Beja counts with 35854 inhabitants. It's located in Alentejo region. Beja was already an important place in antiquity. Already inhabited in Celtic times, the town was later named Pax Julia by Julius Caesar in 48 BCE, when he made peace with the Lusitanians (people from Lusitânia). It's this city that will welcome you all and be the stage for this project.

LANGUAGE COURSE
