

"UPCYCLING FLOATING SAUNA IN NORWAY"

IN STEINSHOLT / NORWAY

The project "Upcycling Floating Sauna in Norway" is a supervised volunteer project that takes place within the framework of the European Solidarity Corps.

Our Norwegian partner is Creatorium, a group of young people who are committed to environmentally friendly and sustainable living and European interaction. Together with the Creatorium association (creatorium.no), the project is being carried out at Skogsro Forest Hostel (www.skogsro.info).

The project is a Rückenwind group project and is open to young people between the ages of 18 and 30 who are resident in a country that participates in the European Solidarity Corps.

No previous experience in this area of work is necessary, only motivation is important.

If you are open-minded and interested in gaining new learning experiences in the field of Upcycling, handicraft work, physical work, working in a group, then this is the right place for you!

The working language will be English, but your basic knowledge is sufficient.

The project deals with the following topics:

• Upcycling/building a floating sauna: Woodwork: Cutting, sawing, gluing, preparing anchors, screwing, learning about traditional woodworking techniques

- Assistance with forest maintenance and woodwork
- Permaculture gardening: Together you will help with three permaculture gardens and learn a lot about garden cultivation, care and the philosophy and theory of cultivation with permaculture.

• Short travelled food: In the spirit of sustainability, you will experiment with seasonal and local produce from our neighbours and develop menu options and cook delicious sustainable food yourself.

Accomodation and catering

During the project, all volunteers will live together in Skogsro Forest Hostel, Creatorium's base camp. Accommodation will be in dormitories where you will share a room with three more volunteers of the same gender. You will have to share your room and sleep in bunk beds, so please be prepared for this. There are shared bathrooms, common rooms and shared kitchens that are also used by Creatorium staff and other visitors, so we will be together all the time. Creatorium will provide sheets and towels, you do not need to bring your own.



Meals will be served during the on-arrival training in the first days, after those days the volunteers will have the opportunity to prepare meals themselves and shop for food together with the local staff. We will also pick up local ingredients from the farmers!

We shop and cook together, and the food budget is managed jointly. Please inform us as early as possible if you have any allergies or intolerances so that we can make appropriate preparations. Alcohol is not permitted in the halls of residence; smoking is permitted in designated outdoor areas.

Travel

You organise your own travel to Steinsholt, the travel costs will be reimbursed up to the ESK flat rates for travel expenses (see table below).

Due to the proximity to the accommodation, travelling via OSLO TORP (TRF) is the easiest and best way to get to the project.

Pocket money

You will receive €8/day pocket money, i.e. a total of €167 for 22 days in the project. This will be transferred to your account. You can do what you want with your pocket money!

Working hours

All volunteers work 5 days a week, approximately 35 hours. As a rule, weekends are free and not working hours. During events, volunteers may have to work at the weekend. This is compensated with time off during the week.
