Lääneranna Youth Center's goal is to involve young people in the community. We work with schools and kindergartens. We organize a variety of youth events and offer everyday leisure activities. Every month there are exciting workshops, and a couple of times a year we organize youth parties. In the summer, there is a work camps and a youth day, we take part in various local and international projects.

Lääneranna Youth Center manages several youth centers/youth clubs in the region:

- Lihula Youth Center;
- Lõpe Youth Center;
- Varbla Youth Center;
- Kõmsi Youth Center;
- Koonga Youth Center.

The work varies and in total we are hoping to host 12 volunteers to help out with summer camps organised in the region in July 2022.

# WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We are looking for our future volunteer to:

- be aged 18-30 (according to European Solidarity Corps programme rules);
- know English at least on a basic level;
- have great interest towards volunteering and youth camps;
- enjoy spending time with kids and youth.

The specific competences are not required beforehand, but if you have some experience with kids, know multiple languages or have volunteered before, please let us know.

Becoming a volunteer doesn't require any specific knowledge.

We are waiting a volunteer who wishes to challenge themselves, tryout different activities with kids, share their culture and traditions with us and in return learn more about Estonian customs.

We, as a hosting organisation, create the safe environment for you to learn and experience. You're more than welcome to also initiate your own activities and bring new ideas to our small community.

## WHAT YOU CAN DO IN OUR PROJECT?



First and foremost you can have MANY MANY MANY activities with youth. You will be working alongside with our youth workers to help to plan and prepare the summer camp that is held from 11-24th of July. The activities are not only creating workshops for youth, but also interview the locals, create visuals, take photos of the activities done, so the local community can better see the value of youth work.

As a volunteer, you'll have a mentor and supervisor and all the support from our small team. All the tasks are given as clearly as possible and we will have weekly meetings to discuss and reflect on the activities.

Once you have sent in your documents, the supporting organisation will send you a confirmation e-mail and if needed, will specify some details. **For applying please send all your documents to supporting organisation!**

Eventually, all the documents are collected and looked through by the hosting organisation who then invites you to a video interview to tell you more about:

- the project;
- the local community;
- your working tasks.

The common meeting is a good way for the hosting organisation to understand your motivation and interest and hear more about you as a person while you can also ask all the questions about the planned activities, see the people in the hosting organisation and understand better if this activity is for you!

Remember that the practical aspects of the project will be organised and coordinated by the supporting organisation Continuous Action in cooperation with Lääneranna Youth Center. Questions about practical details (e.g. travel reimbursement, accommodation, pocket money, etc) can be directed to supporting organisation.
